

Work Health and Safety Policy

Global Experience recognises its moral and legal responsibilities under occupational health and safety legislation to provide a safe and healthy work environment.

This commitment means that we will:

- Provide a safe and healthy workplace and working conditions for all, including employees, casuals, contractors, customers, clients and visitors
- Provide training to enable all employees to work safely
- Comply with all relevant legislation and standards
- Provide health and safety support and assistance to employees
- Consult with employees to enhance our work, health and safety
- Provide adequate resources to help employees fulfil their health and safety responsibilities
- Conduct investigations into any incidents and, if required, ensure appropriate return to work programs are in place, and
- Conduct annual reviews of our health and safety office procedures.

What employees are expected to do

While at work, all employees will:

- Take reasonable care to ensure our health and safety procedures are implemented at all times
- Identify and support measures to eliminate or minimise unsafe conditions, and
- Assume personal responsibility for their own safety and for the safety of other work colleagues by always working in a safe and appropriate manner.
